

Appointment to the Civil Service Appeals Commission

Her Excellency, the Governor Jane Owen, is inviting expressions of interest for one (1) opening on the **Civil Service Appeals Commission (CSAC)**.

OVERVIEW

The Civil Service Appeals Commission is a quasi-judicial body appointed under the Public Service Management Act (as amended from time to time). Its sole purpose is to consider, and decide upon, appeals from civil servants about personnel-related decisions.

The Commission is comprised of a chairperson and up to six others who, by law, must be independent from both the civil service and political parties.

QUALIFYING CRITERIA

To be appointed as a member of the Commission, persons must meet the criteria set out below:

1. Be a qualified lawyer or have relevant legal expertise.
2. Possess an interest in fairness and equity in the civil service.
3. Must **not** be a civil servant.
4. Must **not** currently be, or have been within the last three years, an elected member of Parliament or held office in a political party.

IMPORTANT NOTE

Members of the Commission are volunteers appointed by Her Excellency, the Governor. The duration of appointment is typically 2 to 4 years.
