




CSAC Appeal 006/2014 – Record of Decision

Appeal 006/2014 was received on 30 July 2014.

The CSAC considered the Appeals Form and supporting documentation and unanimously agreed not to entertain this appeal as the appellant failed to produce evidence of unfairness or bias to satisfy the threshold test in Section 54(2) of the Public Service Management Law (2011 Revision) (the "PSML"). In addition the CSAC took the view that the appeal does not fall within the terms of Part VII of the PSML and that in actuality the numerous appeals being lodged by this appellant are indicative of operational grievances.

The appellant was informed, on 28 August 2014, that the appeal would not be entertained and it advised the best course of action for dealing with these grievances are to try to mediate the situation with the Deputy Governor and/or the Chief Officer, Portfolio of the Civil Service.
